

March Virtue of the Month – Mercy

Lift high the cross, the love of Christ proclaim 'til all the world adore his sacred name.

The fifth Sorrowful Mystery – the Crucifixion – is the love story of our salvation. By his crucifixion and death, Jesus revealed to us the depth of his love for each person. Throughout history artists have tried to capture this image portraying not only the extent of the suffering of Jesus, but also the intensity of the love of the Savior. Reading Scripture passages of the Crucifixion and meditating on an image of the scene causes one to realize why “the world adores his sacred name.” This week find an image of the Crucifixion. Read the Gospel of John, Chapter 19. As you read, pause and ponder on the image reflecting the great love the Lord has for each individual, a love so wonderful that he was willing to die for each one of us.

The SCRIP card program is one of the easiest ways you can help our parish earn free money. We purchase the gift cards at a discount and re-sell them for face value, earning a percentage on EVERY card sold. The percentage ranges from 1.5% to 20%.

Nothing EXTRA out of pocket, just your normal spending, but using gift cards instead of your debit or credit card. It helps the parish earn money.

Parents & Grandparents can also help earn tuition back for the kids who are attending St. Francis de Sales School. The child can earn 50% back of the percentage paid.

Fasting-As a community we observe the Catholic tradition of fasting on Fridays. This simply means that we will not serve any meat options or treats such as ice cream on Fridays until Easter break. Children under 14 and adults over 60 are technically exempt from this practice but are encouraged to participate as families see fit.
