Dear St. Francis Families and Friends,

When you are in education, there is no four letter word you dislike more than SNOW. This word strikes fear in the hearts of teachers and administrators. A snow day not only means students miss valuable classwork, but more importantly these days have in the past been made up in June.

As one can imagine, days made up in June are not always as effective. The hot summer weather and distractions make June days difficult to concentrate to say the least.

Several years ago, the Diocese of Wilmington adopted a different method to make up for snow days. Should school be cancelled due to weather, we do not make up the day in June. Instead, we do something that has become increasingly common across the country. We call it a cyber snow day.

On these days, teachers provide educational work for students to do on this day away from school. It may be in the form of a blizzard bag, a pouch of work given at one time, or as assignments given online using Google Classroom or other online method.

Students work on these assignments at home and submit them online or bring them to school upon their return. Of course, the entire school day can't be recreated, but this comes close to the academic rigor of classwork. This allows us to stick to the last day of school as planned and keep on track with lessons.

For your added information, students have 3 days with which to turn cyber day work into their teacher. This allows students the time to play in the snow on the day school is closed.
