It is with great pride and excitement that I can now announce that we have met our goal of 85% re-enrollment. The students are very happy to have a NUT day on Friday. They will be sliming me on Friday as well. Please keep this in mind when they choose an outfit to wear. While the slime is washable, we don't want to ruin any clothes.

Our new family enrollment has begun and seems to be off to a great start. We will again have waiting lists for some classes. I hope you will invite friends and neighbors to come for a tour of the school. Our most powerful marketing tool is the positive word of mouth shared by current families. Did you know that you can earn money toward your tuition for next year by bringing a new family to St. Francis. You can earn \$100 if the family has one child, \$200 if they bring two children, and \$300 if they will be enrolling three children. Spread the word!

We have officially kicked off the Annual Fund Campaign. Our school board, faculty and staff have all committed to 100% participation in the fund. The money from this fundraising effort will support student programs such as STREAMS related activities, instructional technology and the performing arts. This effort helps us keep tuition increases at a reasonable level. In the coming week you will receive a letter asking for your prayerful consideration to donate to this fund. Our goal this year is \$45,000. We have already reached more than half of this goal with the help of very generous early donations.
