

Dear Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth Grade Student/Parent:

We realize that you like to take advantage of the “Back to School” sales that begin in July. To help with your shopping, we have compiled a list of supplies that your child will need to bring to school. These supplies will be needed all year.

- Pencil case
- 2 packages wide ruled loose leaf paper (**NOT COLLEGE RULED!**)
- 6 thick marble backed, lined copybooks
- 1 5-subject spiral notebook
- #2 pencils with erasers
- Blue or Black ink pens (no pink, purple, aqua, etc.)
- Red, green, and/or orange pen for correcting
- Black fine line marker
- 2 highlighters
- 2 glue sticks
- 12” ruler
- Protractor
- Pocket folders – one for each subject
- One package LINED 3 x 5 index cards
- Earbud headphones
- Backpack (no wheels-they don’t fit in their lockers)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer (6th and 8th only)
- 1 Lysol disinfectant wipes (7th only)
- 2 boxes of sharpened Pencils (Dixon or Ticonderoga only) for Math Class
- 24 sharpened Ticonderoga or Dixon #2 pencils to leave in Art Room
- 6 expo markers for Math Class (Bring one to math class each day).
- No lined sketchbook
- One set (12 or 24 your choice) of colored Sharpie brand markers
- One set (12 or 24 your choice) of colored pencils
- Plain metal manual pencil sharpener
- Adult scissors
- 3 pink erasers to leave in the Art Room
- Chromebook

DO NOT PURCHASE FOR SCHOOL USE: white out, gel pens, feather toppers, character pens, etc. They are only distractions and toys. Assignment books are distributed at the beginning of the year in homeroom.
