October Virtue-Obedience

The first Joyful Mystery - The Annunciation - calls us to look at Mary's reply to God's invitation delivered to her by the Archangel Gabriel. After gaining a fuller explanation about this invitation, Mary responds without hesitation by saying, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word (Luke 1:38)."

Hesitation is generally a reaction experienced by all of us. In small ways we hesitate before crossing a street to look for oncoming traffic and we hesitate when comparing prices before making a purchase. We certainly hesitate to make major life decisions.

Mary did not hesitate in this major decision in giving herself to God to be the mother of His Son. She responded freely and immediately because of her trust in God and His plans. In her relationship with God, Mary knew that to obey Him would never lead her astray.

This week, let us pray that our trust in God may flourish which will allow us to obey His designs for us.

Catholic Identity

Four Marks of the Church – The Catholic Church identifies itself as "one, holy, catholic, and apostolic." These words are professed in the Nicene Creed each Sunday at Mass. They indicate the essential features of the Church. The mark of oneness reflects the unity of the Trinity. God's People profess one Lord, one faith, and one Baptism which allows them to become one People of God. Through Baptism and Confirmation, Catholics become a people consecrated by the Holy Spirit. They strive to grow in holiness by working to live in conformity with the Gospel. The word "catholic" means universal. The Church embraces a diversity of cultures and languages in bringing the Good News to all people. The Church is built upon the foundation of the Apostles' proclamation of the Gospel and so is "apostolic" in remaining faithful to this teaching.

Beginning in sixth grade, students are able to apply for membership in the National Junior Honor Society. Applications will be accepted during the last trimester of the year for students who satisfy the following requirements:

- Students must be in the 6th, 7th, or 8th grades.
- Candidates must have a cumulative scholastic average of 93 in their subjects, achieve a P or G in special subjects, and have Effort and Conduct grades of G or O in other classes.
- Candidates will be evaluated on the basis of service, leadership, character, and citizenship.
- The student fills out an application if they are eligible and submits it on time to be considered.
