Standardized Testing

As you heard at the end of last school year, there has been a problem with Terra Nova reporting nationwide in 2017. CTBS the parent company was purchase by a larger publisher. They were overwhelmed to say the least. We have received a summary version of scores electronically that can be viewed by administrators and test coordinators and have begun to analyze data. We typically use this data to drive instruction, identify gaps and improve programs. In the next few weeks, we should get the home reports. These are a more user friendly version that will be sent home to families as soon as they arrive. Please know that we share your frustration in the delay of reporting on these standardized assessments.
