February Virtue of the Month – Faithfulness

As we move into February, we turn our attention to the Sorrowful Mysteries of the rosary, especially during the Lenten season beginning on Ash Wednesday, (February 14). The virtue for February is faithfulness, a virtue which finds itself as true in celebrating Valentine's Day as it is in reflecting on the Sorrowful Mysteries of the rosary. Just as couples are faithful to one another in their commitment of love, Jesus is faithful to the will of the Father through his Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

Faithfulness may sometimes be regarded as an idea relegated to a chosen few persons because it is perceived as too difficult to live. Yet, it is faithfulness that is sung throughout the Old Testament psalms, lauded in the letters of St. Paul in the New Testament, and commended in the lives of the saints. This week, let us pause and ponder the ways in which faithfulness manifests itself in our lives and give thanks to God for these blessed relationships.
