The first Sorrowful Mystery – The Agony in the Garden – places before us the disappointment of disregard. As Jesus suffered in his prayer and worry about the unfolding events before him, he found himself quite alone. He was abandoned by his closest friends in prayer because they simply could not keep awake. Then, he was completely alone as his friends deserted him in fear. It seems one agony that emerged in this garden was disregard. The beginning of Lent is a good time to pause and ponder our regard for God. We can reflect on whether we are present in prayer on a regular basis each day. Do we make time to converse with the Lord? Then we can think about our physical presence to God who lives in each person. Do we serve their needs knowing that what we do for them is the same as doing for the Lord himself? Our attention to prayer and service is the very focus of Lent.
