<u>Standardized Testing-</u>This year our school in alignment with Diocesan expectations will not be participating in the week long Terra Nova testing as we have in the past. Instead, we are moving to a benchmark assessment. These tests are given 3 to 4 times per year and focus on reading and math. School Safety

Parents should know that administration, faculty and staff continue to receive training in order to ensure the safety of children while at school in all emergency situations. To this end I attended the Active Shooter Training offered by the Wicomico County Sheriff and the Maryland State Police Departments. I will be sharing this information at our Professional Development on Wednesday. Please make sure that you come to the school office, sign in, and wear a badge when you are visiting or volunteering in the building.
