To Jesus through Mary May Focus – Glorious Mysteries

May Virtue of the Month – Devotion

The month of May will conclude our focus on the diocesan theme – To Jesus through Mary – with a focus on the virtue of devotion.

In two weeks we commemorate Pentecost, the second greatest celebration of the liturgical year preceded only by Easter. The Third Glorious Mystery recalls this tremendous event –the Descent of the Holy Spirit. This occasion is recounted at the beginning of the Acts of the Apostles (Chapter 2) and the following 26 chapters of this book tell of the effects of this event. It is fascinating reading that tells how, empowered the Holy Spirit, the Apostles and disciples become witnesses of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ and through Holy Spirit lead many people to him. Each of us has had a personal Pentecost, first at our Baptism, and then, in the fullness of Confirmation. This week let us consider how we serve as witnesses of the Lord and by our lives lead others to him.

BOOST -- or Broadening Options and Opportunities for Students Today -- provides state-funded scholarships for some students who are eligible for the Free or Reduced-Price Lunch Program to attend eligible nonpublic schools. Awards are granted based on household income, with the lowest income served first. In late March 2018, the BOOST Program was renewed for the 2018-2019 school year.
